Tote Bag Weave Along Materials List

- *A rigid heddle loom, at least 60cm wide (although if you have a smaller loom, there is no reason why you couldn't join panels together to make up the width)
- *A 7.5 dent heddle/reed
- *A stick shuttle longer than the width of your project (I use 22" shuttles with my 24" loom)
- *Warping peg and clamps
- *Threading/sleying hook
- *A sewing machine or access to one
- *A serger is handy but not essential
- *Miscellaneous weaving and sewing materials eg, scissors, good quality sewing thread.

Yarns needed:

Warp - Australian 8 ply superwash merino/ light worsted/ dk weight, approximately 187 metres (204.6 yards)

Weft- Same as warp (you may not need to use the same amount as for the warp, but I always like to be safe.)

Other materials you will need:

For the bag-

- *17" x 40" stiff, fusible interfacing
- *17 x 40" lining fabric (duck, canvas, drill, poplin etc)

For the handles-

- *30" x 3.5" stiff, fusible interfacing
- *30 x 3.5" lining fabric
- *Iron for pressing
