Checklist for Setting Up Your Inkle Loom for Tablet Weaving

Preparation

 \Box Choose or create your tablet weaving pattern. Ensure you understand how to read the draft.

 \Box Select and prepare your tablets/cards (label or color-code if needed).

Ensure you have enough cards for the design you wish to weave.

 $\hfill\square$ Choose your warp threads (consider fiber, thickness, and color).

□ Gather your tools: your inkle loom, scissors, a belt shuttle.

Warping the Loom

□ Secure your Inkle Loom to a stable surface or just place it on a flat surface.

□ Count out your cards ready to use and decide which threading method you will use (my online course shows 2 different methods).

 \Box Tie the starting thread to the loom's anchor peg.

□ Thread each card with the corresponding warp threads using your

chosen method (pay attention to the threading direction).

 \Box Follow your pattern to correctly thread the holes in the cards.

Tensioning the Warp

 \Box Ensure the warp threads are evenly tensioned.

 \Box Adjust the tension bar or pegs until the threads are the desired firmness.

Starting to Weave

 \Box Check that the cards rotate smoothly.

 \Box Weave a few rows of waste yarn to even out the warp or place cardboard separators.

□ Verify the pattern alignment and adjust cards if necessary.

Weaving Tips

- \Box Turn the cards as directed in your pattern.
- \Box Beat the weft evenly with your shuttle.
- □ Adjust tension regularly to maintain consistency.
