Weaving Space Organization Checklist

Think you have too little space? Think again! With a little organization and the right storage you may have a lot more useable space than you realise!

Here are some great organising ideas in an easy to read checklist. You can even use the boxes to tick off to help you get really organized!

Yarn Storage:

- □ Use wall-mounted shelves or pegboards to keep yarn visible
- □ Store yarn in clear bins or labeled baskets for easy sorting
- □ Hang mini skeins or scraps in an over-the-door shoe organizer
- □ Use stackable drawers or cubbies to protect yarn from dust

Tool & Accessory Storage:

- □ Hang shuttles, scissors, and other tools on a pegboard or magnetic strip
- □ Organize small tools with drawer dividers or compartment boxes
- □ Keep frequently used tools in a portable caddy for easy access
- □ Repurpose jars, utensil holders, or tackle boxes for heddles and bobbins

Loom Storage & Space-Saving Ideas:

- □ Choose a foldable or compact loom if space is limited
- □ Store frame looms vertically using wall hooks or hanging racks
- □ Use a rolling cart or trolley to keep small looms and supplies mobile
- □ Store unused looms under the bed or in a closet to save space

Keeping Your Space Neat & Functional:

- □ Label bins, baskets, and drawers for quick access to supplies
- □ Create designated work zones for warping, weaving, and finishing
- □ Declutter regularly by sorting through unused yarn and tools

Bonus: Small Space Weaving Hacks

- □ Use multi-purpose furniture (foldable tables, storage ottomans, etc.)
- □ Hang baskets or floating shelves to maximize wall space
- Utilize corners and vertical storage solutions
